

## **Noble Samuel Scholarship Application 2025/26**

Friends of Virgin Islands National Park is sponsoring a scholarship program with the aim of encouraging study, among Virgin Islanders at the university level, with an interest in VI environmental and cultural issues.

The Noble Samuel Scholarship scholarship offered to a St. John or St. Thomas student attending, or entering, an accredited college university with a (planned) major in a field related that will contribute to making the Virgin Islands more environmentally, socially and economically sustainable. This college scholarship is for local youth who demonstrate the leadership skills and community service emblematic of Noble Samuel. The annual scholarship will be in the amount of \$5,000 per academic year (disbursed at the rate of \$2500 per semester). The scholarship includes a paid internship/ employment with Friends of Virgin Islands National Park on St. John during holidays and the summer months.

## To be eligible for the scholarship, students must have:

- St. John or St. Thomas resident and have completed high school in the Virgin Islands (or are currently in the last semester of high school senior year).
- Attained a "B" (3.0) average during their previous (and most recent) three semesters of high school and/or university (whichever is applicable).
- Studying in a field related to natural or cultural resource protection, or a field that will make STJ more environmentally, socially and economically secure.
- 2 Letters of Recommendations, 1 from a teacher/educator
